THE ORIGINAL CIO DEFINITION

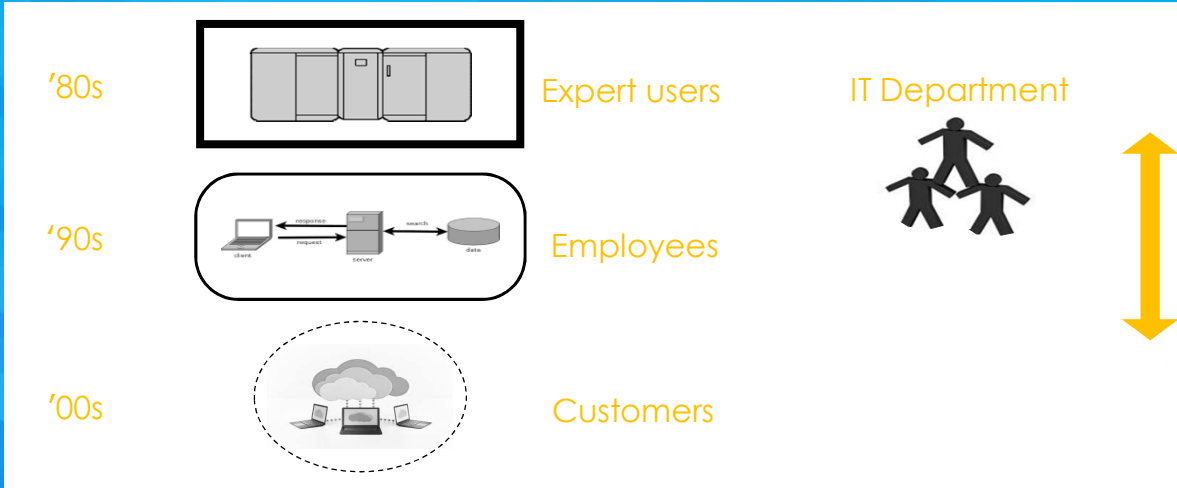
“A senior executive responsible for establishing corporate information policy, standards, and management control over all corporate information resources.” William Synott.

William Synott* is generally credited with coining the label “chief information officer” in a speech at the 1980 Information Management Exposition and Conference.

*American organizational theorist, Vice President of Bank of Boston, author, consultant and lecturer, known for his work in the field of computer technology in business in the 1980s.

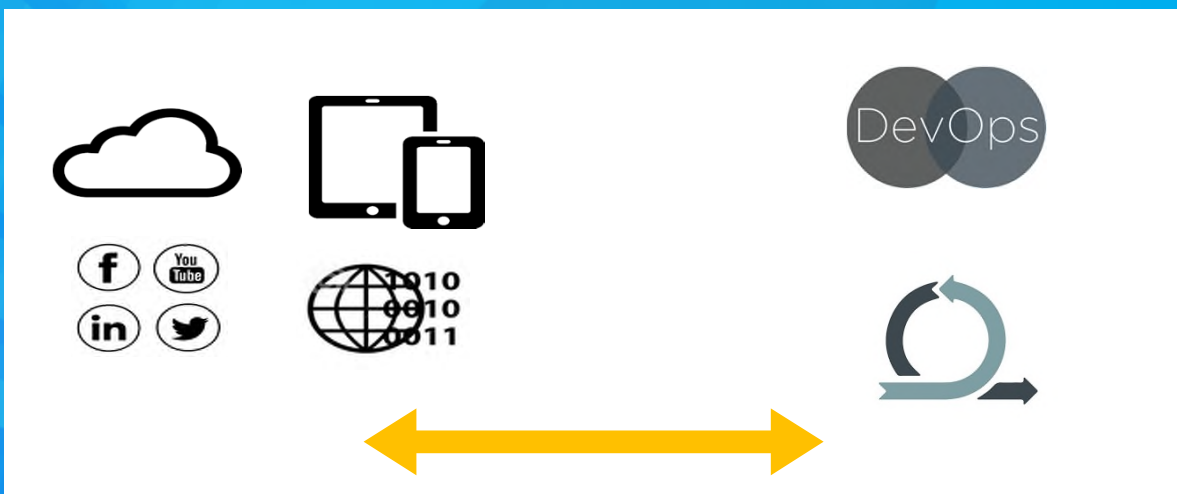

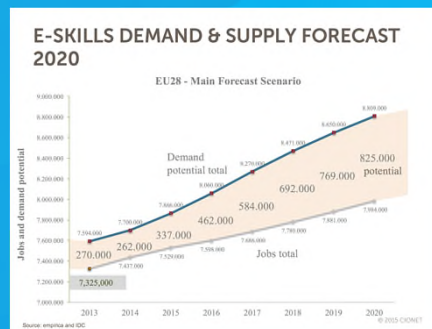
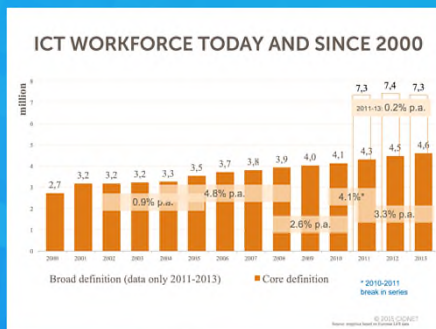
- ▶ CIO focus op Techniek & Legal – niet op HR
